



ULTIMATE CABIN OPENING CHECKLIST

Before your go

- Review your insurance
- Gather your fishing and boating license
- Organize your keys
- Inform your electricity and phone company to turn on your services
- Stock up on cleaning supplies and food.
- Assemble batteries, flashlights, matches, candles, portable charger, bug spray

Outside your cabin

- Inspect power lines and phone lines
- Look for any breakage on windows and roof
- Inspect for any leakage
- Check for dead trees
- Check and repair for any damage on the deck and the dock
- Remove obstructions to the eaves trough and chimney
- Check under cabin - posts, pads, and beams
- Tend to your garden

Inside your cabin

- Open windows for fresh air
- Clean the interior of your cabin
- Change the bedding
- Inspect cupboards, dressers and closets for any mice or insects
- Replace the batteries in your smoke alarm and carbon monoxide detectors
- Refill your fire extinguisher
- Replace filters that may need any change
- Check for cracks on the walls, ceilings, and signs of heave on the floor
- Replace the filters on the central heating and air conditioning
- Check for any waterline cracks under your cabin
- Turn on the water to check if all the taps are running
- Set up the hot water tank
- Look for any mold or mildew
- Pump out your septic tank if it is damp or smells bad
- Stock up your clothing, games, books, and puzzles
- Fill up your kitchenware and other utilities
